

PIP Animal Housing – trial at the ‘Wambeekhoeve’ Dairy Farm**Location:** Wambeek, Belgium**Date:** August 2005 – June 2007**Products used:** PIP AHC, PIP AHS, PIP CFC, PIP CTC and PIP CFC RTU.**Co-ordinator:** Guy Vossen**Goal of the test**

To verify the effects of PIP Animal Housing cleaning on the general hygiene of a dairy farm.

Results

Before starting the use of the PIP Animal Housing Cleaning products the general hygiene at the dairy farm was poor. As a result, the herd suffered from severe health problems including high cell counts of 400,000 and that 40% of the herd had problems with their feet. These problems had been present for years.

After 3 months of using PIP Animal Housing Cleaning products an improvement of the situation was achieved. The general level of hygiene strongly increased. As a result, the cell count dropped to 230 000. The general condition of the cows increased; the cows are shining.

A check up was done 2 years later, and there were no problems. A sustainable situation had been achieved.
